Dear Mrs. Christina MyKhanh Hoang!

In the name of the Mother General of the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy, I have the joy of informing you about our positive response to your request for St. Faustina's relic for the Divine Mercy Movement operating at the Church of Our Lady of Fatima in Fort Worth, United States. We are granting you a piece of her relic *ex ossibus* because of the involvement of your Movement in the mission of St. Faustina and your propagation of devotion to Divine Mercy.

At the same time, we inform you that the relics are given to a particular Parish, for public worship, and cannot be transferred to another Church. We also keep a register of relics issued, where we post the addresses of Parishes that have received relics.

We warmly thank you, for inviting St. Faustina in the sign of her relic, to your religious community and faithful. We pray that it may help both deepen the spiritual friendship between you and the Secretary and Apostle of the Merciful Jesus as well as your involvement in St. Faustina's mission of showing the world the beauty of Divine Mercy through deed, word and prayer. St. Faustina's desire written in her "Diary" is thus further fulfilled: *I desire to go throughout the whole world and speak to souls about the great mercy of God (Diary 491). This is my mission, which You Yourself have entrusted me, O Lord, in this life and in the life to come (D 1325).*

This was also the desire of St. John Paul II, who during his last pilgrimage to the Shrine of Divine Mercy in Cracow said: *This fire of mercy needs to be passed on to the world. In the mercy of God the world will find peace and mankind will find happiness! And his words spoken in Błonie Park, Cracow: The hour has come when the message of Divine Mercy is able to fill hearts with hope and to become the spark of a new civilization: the civilization of love.*

We pray that the spiritual presence of St. Faustina by means of her relic bring many blessed fruits in the life of your Movement and fill your hearts with joy, for the Lord Jesus said: *For your sake, I grant blessings to this whole vicinity* (D. 719), *for your sake I will bless the earth* (D. 431). May she lead you along the road of trust and mercy and implore all necessary graces for you and all those entrusted to your apostolic care.

We kindly inform you that due to the sacredness of relics, they being part of a saint's body, we do not send them by mail. And so receive our heartfelt invitation for you, or for the person who will be authorized in writing, to come and collect the relic of St. Faustina from our convent here at the Shrine of Divine Mercy in Cracow-Łagiewniki. Kindly give us a two-week notice before your planned arrival by sending us an email at: misja@faustyna.pl

We kindly remind you that relics are sacred objects, a divine gift, thus they are not for sale. Relic preparation however, involves some costs. And so, as far as it's possible, we kindly ask for an offering to cover the cost of a gilded capsule. Special gilded reliquaries are available for purchase from us.

Our heartfelt greetings to you, and to all your Movement! Be assured that we remember you in our prayers before the famous miraculous Image of the Merciful Jesus and the tomb of St. Faustina here at the Shrine of Divine Mercy in Cracow and we ask for your prayer as well.
